Important Information About Your Class “A” Liquor Control License

New laws passed in 2022 made changes to retail alcohol license classifications. Your license, the class “A” liquor control license, was reclassified to a class “F” retail alcohol license.

What does this mean for you?

Your class “A” liquor control license has been automatically changed to a class “F” retail alcohol license in the eLAPS licensing system. The letters in your license number have been changed from “LA” to “LF”. The license number itself has not changed. Your effective and expiration dates have not changed.

On or before Friday, November 18, 2022 you will receive a new class “F” retail alcohol license by email to be printed and displayed on your licensed premises.

Your alcohol sales privileges have not changed. The class “F” retail alcohol license continues to allow you to sell alcoholic liquor, wine, and beer for on-premises consumption to your club members and their guests.

You will notice a decrease in your license fee when you renew your class “F” retail alcohol license. This is because Sunday sales are no longer an additional privilege with an additional fee. Sunday sales are allowed and included in your base license fee.
